

Our younger pupils focussed on Number activities and challenges whilst our Year 2 to Year 6 pupils focussed on Times Tables. We run this as an enterprise event where every class uses their literacy and numeracy skills to design, make and run stalls so that all profits are given back to the classes to purchase items for use in their learning in the classroom. I'd like to give it 11 out of 10 but that's not possible, so a definite 10 out of 10 – Brilliant!


World Book Day
